Don't know what to do? The criteria can be downloaded from the region's website or follow the directions below.

Specifications: Size: 3'x 5' Must have:

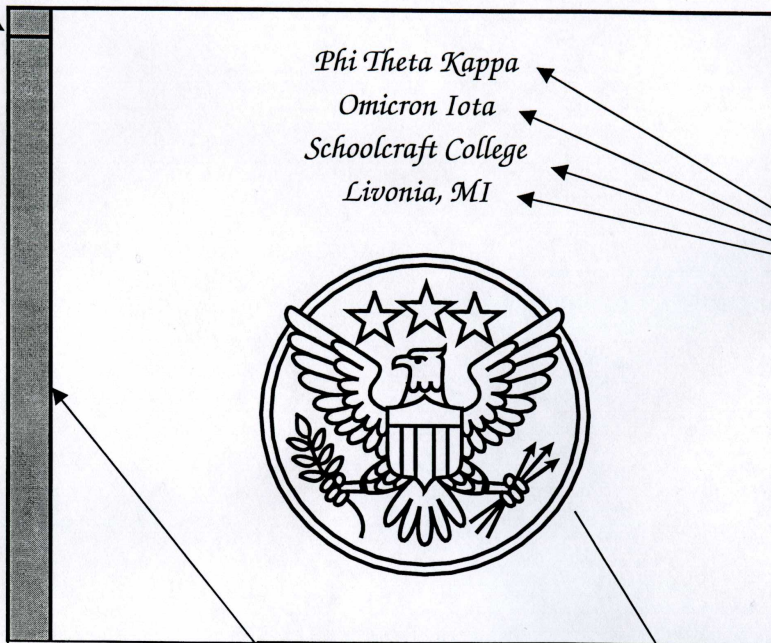
- Phi Theta Kappa
- Chapter Name
- Chapter School
- City, State (location)

Include your choice of symbol, clip art and/or applique that represents your chapter or school. Stitch a 3-4" seam pocket from the top to the bottom on the left hand side of the flag. Stitch the top of the pocket closed to accommodate the flag rod. YOU MUST supply your own flag pole. The pole diameter should not exceed 2". Suggestions: Fabric or felt application is recommended. Use durable materials that will stand the test of time.

EXAMPLE ONLY

Stitch closed the top, to hold a rod you will insert



Note: This example in no way restricts you in the actual set up of your flag. You are free to design your flag. You are only required to include the required criteria.

Required Information Note: This may be located anywhere on the flag, but definitely visible!

Specifications:
Size: 3' X 5'
Must have:
Phi Theta Kappa
Chapter Name
Chapter School
City, State (Location)

Stitch a 3" or 4" seam pocket from top to bottom on the left-hand side.

Choice of symbol, clip art or applique representative of your chapter or school

YOU MUST supply your own flag pole. We will provide a stand for your flag. The pole diameter should not exceed 2".

Suggestions: Fabric or Felt application is recommended. Durable material to last.
